Dear Sorors:

Pursuant to the National Constitution and Bylaws (Article XIII – DISCIPLINE, Section 2. J.), if a soror/member has not satisfied her fine or financial obligation within a five year period from the expiration of the sanction, she will be expelled from the organization by the National President.

This memorandum serves as official notification to any soror that was sanctioned after July 1, 2013 must have satisfied her fine or financial obligation, within a five year period from one's expiration date. If your sanction is identified as unpaid by the designated deadline your membership will be revoked and you will be expelled from the sorority.

In order to become a soror in good standing with the organization you must submit your entire fine payment by the designated date. Payments can be made in installments no less than \$25 (leading up to your sanction end date). Upon receipt of your paid in full fine payment by National Headquarters, you will be eligible to submit dues and any applicable fees to a local chapter or as a member-at-large in order to become an active financial member of the organization.

There are three ways in which a fine can be paid: credit card, certified check or money order. Certified checks and money orders should be made out to Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. and it is recommended that you attach a return receipt to retain for your personal records. Please include your name and your member number.
